### 2016 Wood Badge Course Survey Results

- Of the scouters who have served 20 + years who attended course, 60% said the course Highly Improved their knowledge of Scouting. The remaining 40% noted Some Improvement to their knowledge of Scouting.

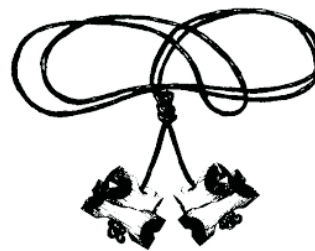
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## Course Information

- Be a registered BSA leader
- Complete Basic Trainings
- Complete parts A, B & C of the BSA Annual Health and Medical Record Form
- Have a BSA uniform
- Be able to function safely outdoors
