Must attend all sessions

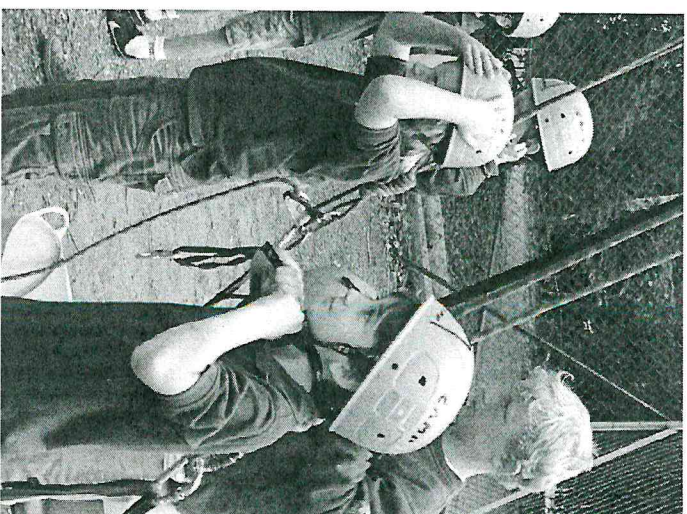

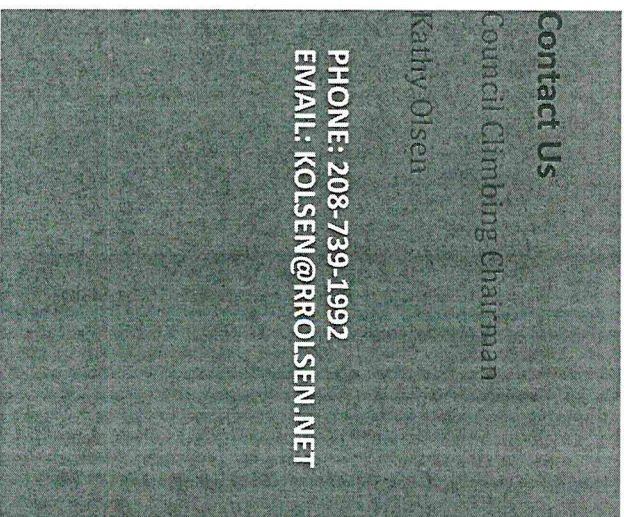
